We are very proud of our academy and pupils and we want others to see them in the same light.

A smart uniform that is worn properly gives a good impression and shows that the children are part of a proud academic family.

Pupils should wear:

- Maroon V neck sweatshirt or cardigan – with school logo (The sweatshirt will have a blue stripe in the neck, cuff and welt; burgundy jumpers are not appropriate)
- Blue and maroon stripe tie (Year 1 to 6) these must be worn. Lost ties will need to be replaced and cost £5.95
- White shirt (white polo shirt for Nursery & Reception)
- Charcoal grey trousers/skirt
- Black school shoes NO trainers.

Some parents have experienced difficulties finding Charcoal grey. Please ensure trousers/skirts are grey *not* black.

By now all jumpers and ties paid for by the school should have been collected. If you have any problems please just let us know.

Please make sure all items, including ties are labelled with your child's name.

Care Club Breakfast facility.

From this morning, Care Club will be running the breakfast facility in school.

Breakfasts will include a range of cereals (rice crispies, weetabix, shredded wheat etc) or toast with a choice of toppers e.g. butter, jam, marmite.

If you wish your child to come to school for breakfast there are two options.

- 1) 7:45 8:45 provides an hours child care and a breakfast at a cost of £3.00
- 2) 8:30 8:45 a supervised breakfast at a cost of £1.00

A letter was sent out last week with details regarding payment. If you have any queries please do not hesitate to contact the school office.

Year 2 and 6 national tests

Year 2 will have their national assessment tests during the week commencing 9th May 2016.

It is crucial year 2 and year 6 children are not off during this week.

Parking

Just a reminder to think carefully about your parking and driving around the Academy.

For the safety of our children, DO NOT park on the pavement nearest to the school.

Parentpay

Parentpay is up and working as usual.

All monies coming into school for key items are payable via Parentpay.

We strongly suggest that:

- You ensure money is available in advance for care club, (including breakfast) and dinner money.
- You pay direct via your bank card not by using bar-coded letters. Barcoded letters take 48 hours to process.

The school does not run a debt system so fees need to be paid promptly. Any debt will mean you have no access to facilities until the money owed is cleared.

Parent's Breakfast Club

The parent's breakfast club will continue to run on Friday mornings 9 – 10pm.

The club is run by our kitchen staff as part of the Chartwells catering team so remember to bring along your money to purchase your teas/coffees and breakfast.

The first club will be this Friday 18th September 2015.
