We hope you had a happy and restful Easter and have had chance to recharge your batteries ready for the busy summer term. We have a number of events planned for our children and parents so please make a note of the *diary dates* and add them to your calendar. Thank you to all who attended the *parent consultations* at the end of last term (84% of parents were committed to staying informed about their child's learning). It was a real pleasure to be able to report the progress and achievements your children are accomplishing.

Whilst at the consultations, the governors and senior leadership team carried out a *parent survey*. The results of this survey are currently being analysed and the detailed results will be sent to you soon. Following a quick glance, the vast majority was very positive and indicated that parents were happy with their child's education at Sun Academy Bradwell. We take your comments very seriously and use them to guide our school improvement.

Two aspects, which you want us to consider, are *after-school clubs* and a review of the *behaviour system*. We will re-introduce some clubs for the end of the school day and these will commence the week beginning 22nd April. A letter will be sent home at the start of next week. We will also be reviewing the school's positive behaviour procedures. A further questionnaire focused on behaviour will come home: I strongly advise you fill this in and return it so that you can have your say. Pupils, staff and governors will also be consulted and assist with the review. A working party will then meet to finalise our procedures and consider any changes that need making. Parents will be invited to be part of this working party. Any changes and new procedures will come into effect from September 2018.

If you didn't get a chance to complete the parent questionnaire but would like to, please collect a paper copy from the school reception.

Please take a good look through this half terms newsletter – it really does give you lots of information about our school. If you would like a paper copy, just let us know and we can send one home with your child.

We look forward to another successful term, working in partnership with you. Thank you for your constant and continued support.
