## Snack

Please ensure that all snacks from home are healthy snacks. These should be low in sugar and fat content. This includes both food and drinks. Any children with unhealthy snacks will be asked to leave them in their bags and will be provided with fruit as an alternative. This will be charged to your parent pay account.



## Mobile Phones

From Monday, please note that mobile phones are not allowed in school. If a child brings a phone into school this MUST be handed into the school office and collected at the end of the day. Any child seen with a mobile phone in their bags or hand will have it confiscated. This will then need to be collected from the office by a parent. Children do not need mobile phones in school.



## From September 2019

Due to health and safety, we will be making some changes from September 2019:

### **Bags and Equipment-**

Please only buy a book bag for your child as we will not be allowing rucksacks into the school as we do not have the room to store them. Children will be provided with all of the equipment needed for lessons therefore, individual pencil cases will not be needed.

**P.E kits-** Children will need a P.E kit in a size appropriate bag. All items should be labeled with your child's name to ensure items can be easily identified. These will be stored in the children's lockers or pegs.

**Water Bottles-** Please ensure your child has a water bottle in school, clearly labeled. They have constant access to water which will keep them hydrated throughout the day.

## Uniform

Please ensure that your child comes to school in the correct school uniform.

Items are listed below:

- Jumper with school logo
- Dark grey trousers
- Shirt and tie (year 1 and above)
- Polo shirt (Early Years)
- Black shoes

Please note that full shoes should be worn in the summer rather than sandals for health and safety reasons.

Thank you to all of the children who come to school smartly dressed. If incorrect uniform is worn, children will wear pumps and a tie from the school office.

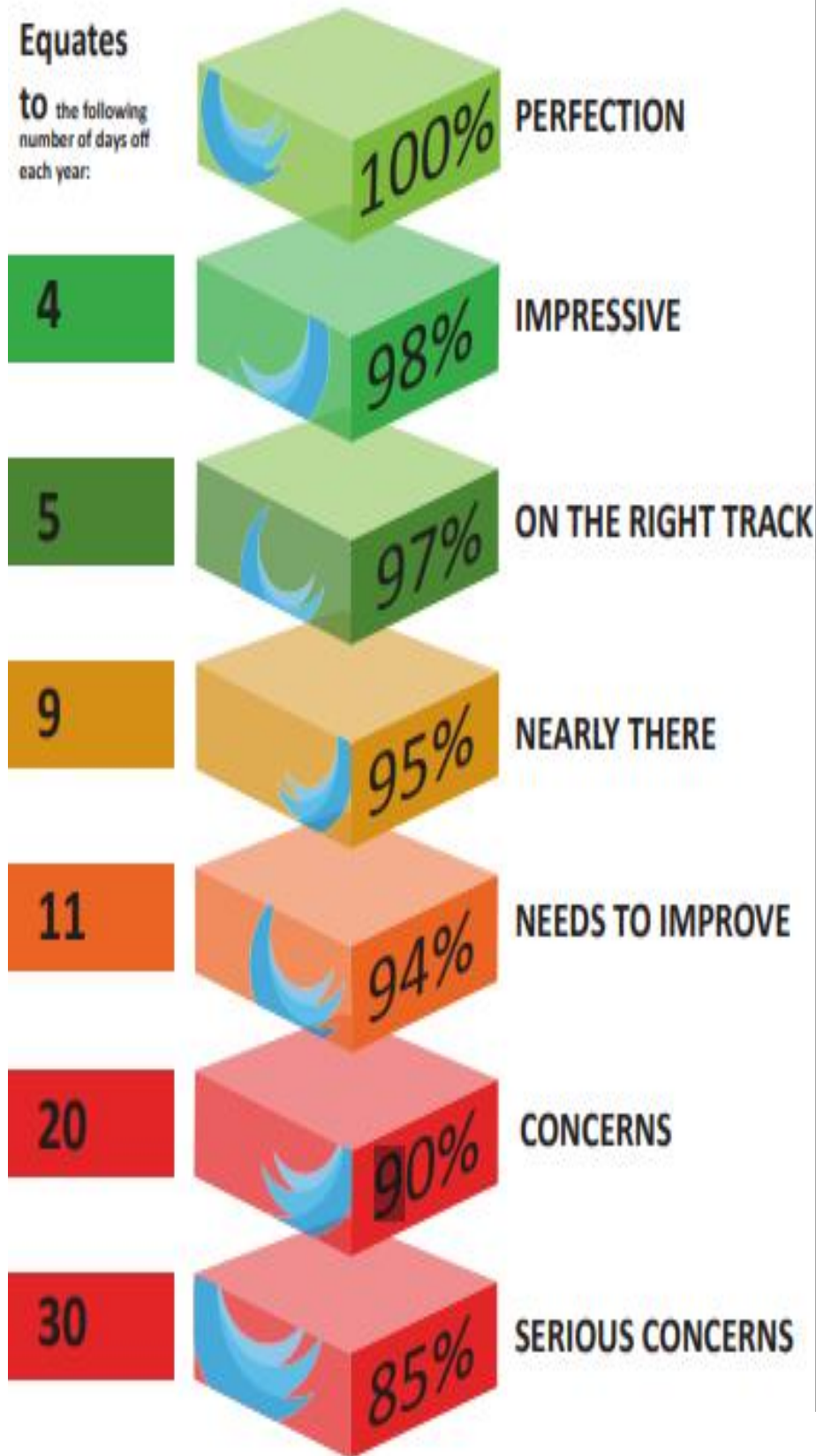
