From September 2019

Due to health and safety, we will be making some changes from September 2019:

Bags and Equipment- Please only buy a book bag for your child as we will not be allowing rucksacks into the school as we do not have the room to store them. Children will be provided with all of the equipment needed for lessons therefore, individual pencil cases will not be needed.

P.E kits- Children will need a P.E kit in a size appropriate bag. All items should be labelled with your child's name to ensure items can be easily identified. These will be stored in the children's lockers or pegs.

Water Bottles- Please ensure your child has a water bottle in school, clearly labelled. They have constant access to water which will keep them hydrated throughout the day.

Uniform

Please ensure that your child comes to school in the correct school uniform.

Items are listed below:

- Jumper with school logo
- Dark grey trousers
- Shirt and tie (year 1 and above)
- White polo shirt (Early Years)
- Black shoes

Please note that full shoes should be worn in the summer rather than sandals for health and safety reasons.

When notes or explanations are provided by parents, children are given a day's grace in relation to incorrect uniform.
