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UNAUTHORISED ABSENCE

IMPORTANT INFORMATION Holidays during term time.

You have to get permission from the Principal if you want to take your child out of school during term time.

You can only do this if:

- you make an application to the principal in advance
- •there are EXCEPTIONAL circumstances

Legislation issued in February 2015 dictates that you may be fined if your child has 10 sessions (five days) of unauthorised absence.

Fines are being issued for unauthorised absences in our academy.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Arrival at school - guidance

Recently a number of children have been arriving at school very early and therefore are not properly supervised.

Children **should not** arrive at school **before 8:30am** unless attending the care club.

Staff cannot take responsibility for children before 8:45am

Please do not allow your children to play on the outdoor equipment at the start and end of the school day.

Please also note that we do not allow motorized scooters etc.
These should be left at home.
Children should be reminded that they should not rider their bikes/scooters on the school playground as we do not want pedestrians to get accidently hurt.
