	SCA3: Light	
Phase 1	 recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light notice that light is reflected from surfaces recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object find patterns in the way that the size of shadows change. 	DTA1: Light up signs / DTA2: Greeting cards	
Phase 5	 use research (investigate and analyse a range of existing products) and develop design criteria to inform the design of appealing products that are fit for purpose. generate, develop, model and communicate their ideas through discussion, annotated sketches, cross-sectional and exploded diagrams, prototypes, pattern pieces and computer-aided design select from and use a wider range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks [for example, cutting, shaping, joining and finishing], accurately evaluate their ideas and products against their own design criteria and consider the views of others to improve their work Explore why greeting cards are sent at times of celebration. Reflecting on previous learning, explore why people may want light up signs → investigate and analyse illuminated signs →understand how LEDs may be used instead of traditional incandescent bulbs in series circuits →develop ideas for a decorative illuminated sign → select and use tools, equipment, materials and components to make the enclosure of a decorative illuminated sign → construct a working circuit with one or more lights, and fit it in a decorative illuminated sign. Create Diwali greeting cards → discuss other greeting cards for this time of year →design and make Christmas cards
