

Anti-bullying Week and Children in Need

Next week is Anti-bullying week with the theme of 'Choose Respect'. All children will be participating in a series of activities based on this theme:

Monday 12th November - All are to come into school in **normal uniform** but wearing odd socks; an Anti-bullying week assembly.

Tuesday 13th November - PHSE lessons based around anti-bullying.

Wednesday 14th November - Reverend Karen's Assembly.

Thursday 15th November - Our main focus day. All are to come in to school in non-uniform in colours which represent one part of a rainbow as follows:

Y6 – Red

Y5 – Orange

Y4 – Yellow

Y3 – Green

Y2/Y1 – Blue

YR/YN – Indigo/Violet (purples)

Each class will then have all lessons around different topics to do with anti-bullying, such as: difference and diversity; choose respect; rainbow actions; strategies and ways to combat bullying (Stop Speak Support).

Friday 16th November – Children in Need with the theme of, 'Do Your Thing'.
