Please make sure you update your details in the office if they change.

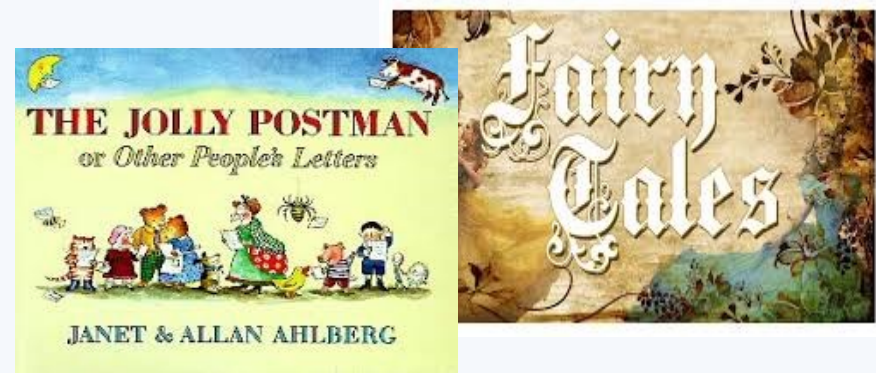
If your child will be absent from school, please phone or text the school office before 9:10 so that the registers can be recorded accurately.

Autumn Term 2017

This term we will be learning all about classic fairy tales. We will be using the book *The Jolly Postman* as an introduction to a range of stories.

In Communication and Language we are learning:-



To listen with interest to stories and conversations.

We will be retelling stories and following a story without pictures.

We will be asking and answering lots of questions and giving explanations.

In Personal and Social we are learning:

To play in a group with our friends inside and in the outdoor classroom.

We will become confident to talk about the things we like to do at home and at school during snack chat and circle time.

We will be learning how actions have consequences and affect other people.

In Physical development we are learning:-

We will be completing activities that help to strengthen our core muscles. We will also be learning about the appropriate safety measures when using PE equipment.

We will also be getting our fingers ready for writing with fun activities like dough disco. We will be mark making and writing as often as possible.

Nursery's PE day is on a **Wednesday** and Reception's is on a **Thursday**.

Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school.

In English we are learning:-

To repeat words and phrases from our favourite stories, describe story settings and recognise familiar words and logos.



We will be doing lots of writing at our indoor and outdoor writing stations giving meaning to the different marks we make.

We will have a daily phonics lesson where we need our listening ears!! This will help us with our reading and writing.

Please read daily with your child and make use of our Active Learn resource.

In Maths we are learning:-



We will be learning to count forwards and backwards up to 10 (or higher) taking part in many activities to spark our interest in number with opportunities to comment and ask questions. We will be doing lots of number work.

During our work on shape we will go on shape hunts in the environment, play positional language games and learn mathematical names for 2D and 3D shapes.

In Nursery the focus will be on counting 1:1—in reception we will be completing addition and subtraction problems.

In Understanding of the World we are learning:

To talk about our family and friends learning about similarities and differences. We will be developing an understanding of growth and decay using our green fingers in the outdoor garden.

We will be commenting on nature and season changes.

We will be learning about different occupations.

We will be using ICT to help our learning, including working with technical toys and equipment.



In Art and Music we are learning:-

About the artist Howard David Johnson; who uses fairy tales as his stimulus and we will be looking to do the same..

We will be moving to music and being imaginative.

We will be using our indoor and outdoor role play areas to act out narratives and actions within certain situations; such as using a Post Office.
