

Dear Parents,

As the end of the year quickly approaches, we are looking to provide all of the children at Sun Academy Bradwell with the opportunity to visit the academy for half a day to see their friends, say goodbye to the staff within their current year group and begin to form relationships with the staff that will be teaching them next year. For those children who have not attended the academy since March due to the national pandemic, this will also give them the opportunity to become familiar with the current academy layout and systems.

In order to provide space for the transition visits safely, children in Year 1 and Year 6 will revert to home learning from Monday 13th July, therefore Thursday 9th July will be the last day of face to face learning within the academy. Reception and Nursery places will continue to be offered alongside places for key worker and vulnerable children until the end of the academic year.

Transition visit times are listed below (current classes)

The academy is currently operating a one way system for drop off and collection with floor markings outlining the 2 meter distancing. All children will enter through the main car park gate where they will be directed to the relevant door by the members of staff outside; this will also be the door that children are collected from. The exit will be via the pedestrian gate immediately after dropping your child off. Children do not need to bring anything into the academy; all drinks and snacks will be provided.

In order to prepare resource packs for your child to use during the transition visit, your child's class teacher will phone you and your child next week to confirm their attendance for the transition visit.
