# Wobbly Pot

The pinching technique can be used to make a simple pinch pot like the one featured in this project. Throughout time, and in many different cultures, this style of pot has been used for various purposes. A good example is the diya pot used to hold small lights during the Hindu festival of Diwali.

- YOU WILL NEED**  
 Air-drying clay  
 Sponge  
 Modelling tool  
 Acrylic paints  
 Paintbrushes



**1** Use the pinching technique (see page 8) to create a simple pot shape.



**2** Squeeze the top of the pot to create a wavy edge. Leave it for half an hour to dry slightly.



**3** Roll three small balls of clay.



**4** Score and moisten the surfaces to be joined (see page 10), then gently press each ball on to the base of the pot to form 'feet'. Smooth around the joins with a modelling tool. Leave to dry (see page 11).



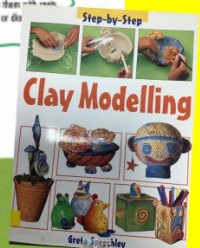
**5** Use a sponge to add large wavy stripes of paint around the pot.



**6** Dip a stiff paintbrush or old toothbrush into acrylic paint, then hold it over the pot and rim and pull back the bristles with your finger. This will create a spattered paint effect. Wash your hands immediately afterwards.



**FURTHER IDEAS**  
 You can make wide and narrow pots - egg-cup tea. Decorate them with stars or dots.



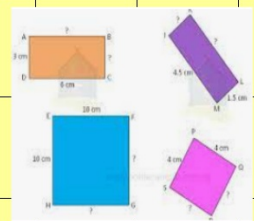

## Year 1 Term 1B Overview

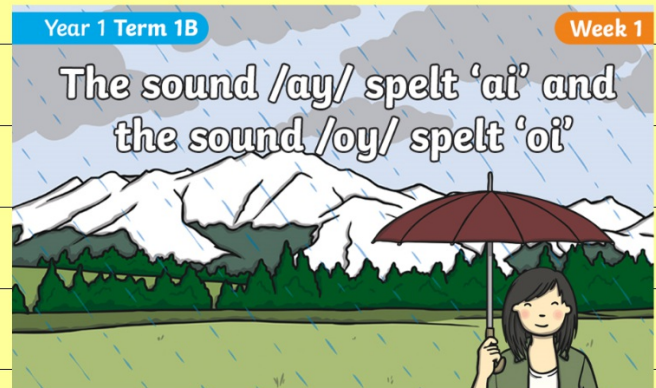
Objectives that are in pink are a Y1 statutory requirement and individual words highlighted pink are from the Y1 non-statutory example words and their exceptions. The additional words and sets (in black) either reinforce the rule/ pattern being taught; revise previously visited spelling rules from lower year groups; practise a spelling rule linked to a Y1 statutory requirement or practise the common exception words. Each set of spellings contains 10 words linked to the objective. Please note all of the common exception words are not covered in these lists.

Week 1 The digraphs 'ai' and 'oi' are hardly ever used at the end of English words.	Week 2 The digraphs 'ay' and 'oy' are used for those sounds at the end of words and at the end of syllables.	Week 3 The sound /oa/ spelt with the vowel digraphs 'oa', 'ow', 'oe' (oa is very rare at the end of a word)	Week 4 The sound /ee/ spelt 'e' and with the vowel digraph 'ee'	Week 5 The vowel digraph 'ea'	Week 6 The vowel digraph 'ie' making the /igh/ and / ee/ sounds	Week 7 Review Week

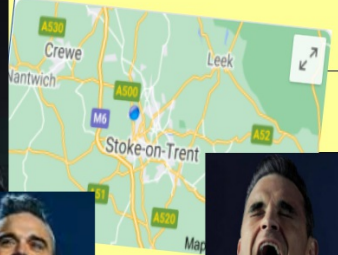
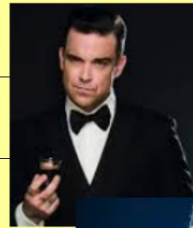

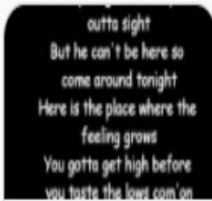
