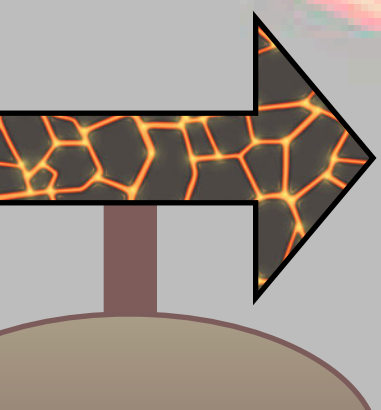

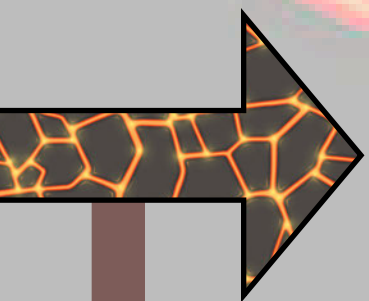
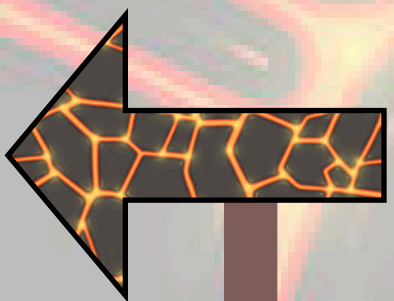

in Tokyo, Japan.



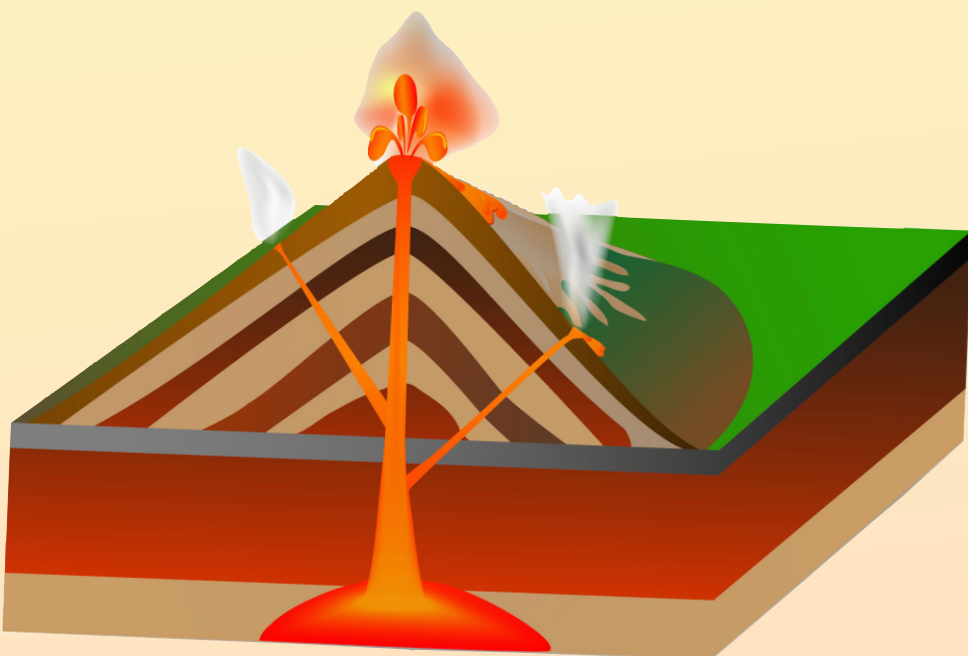

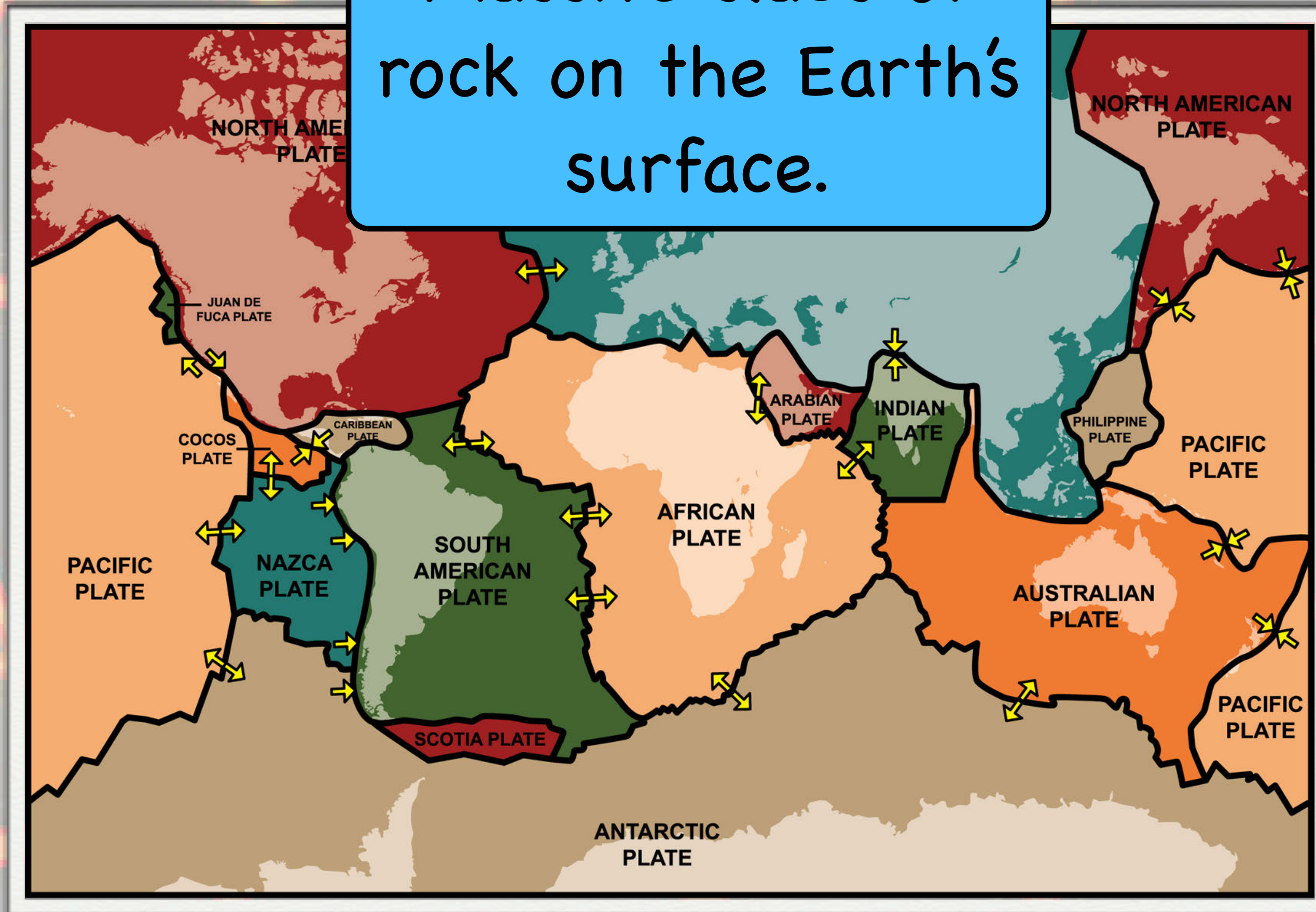
Plastic moulds

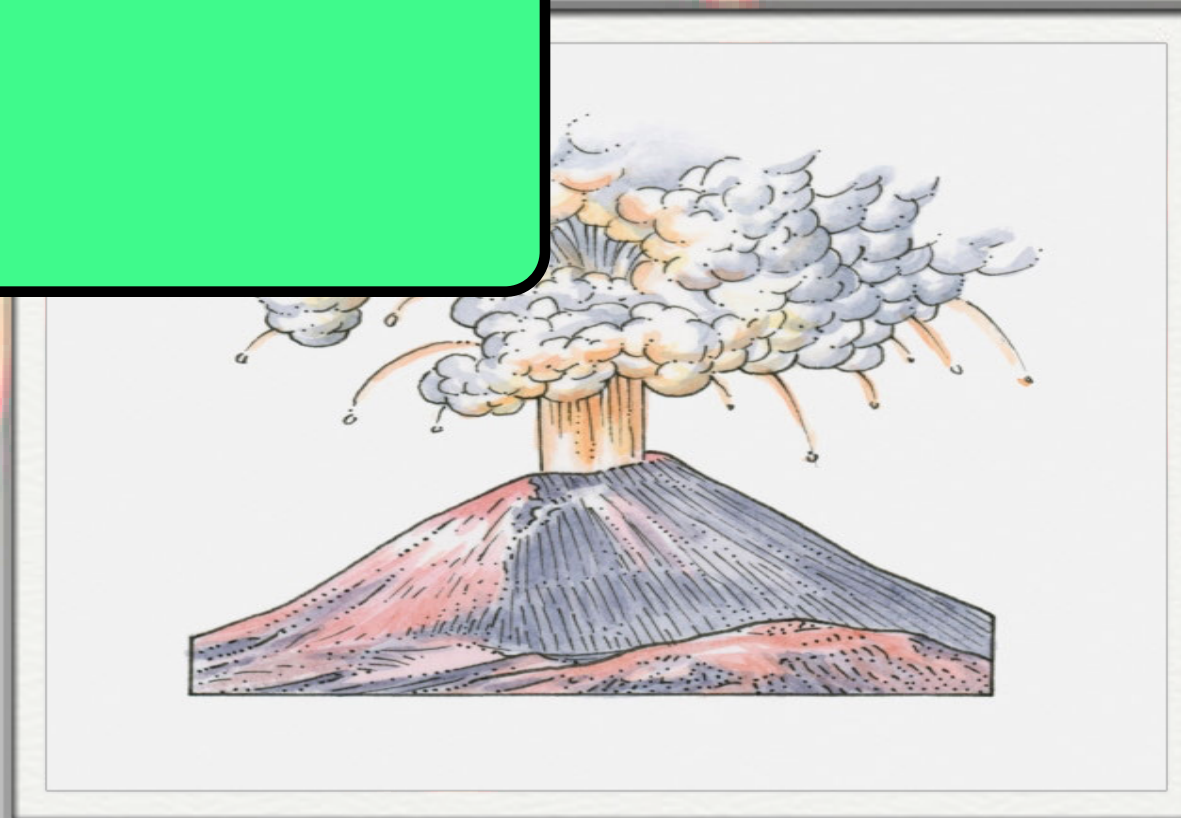

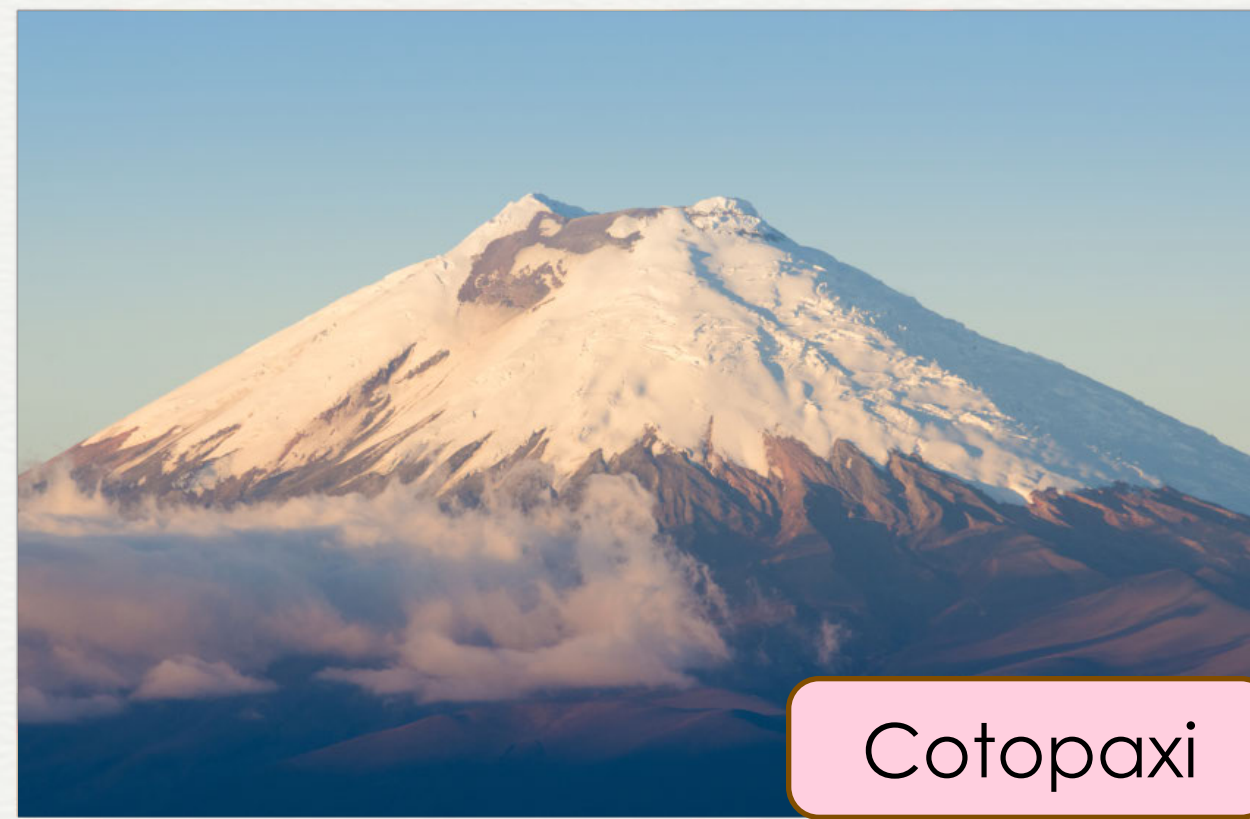

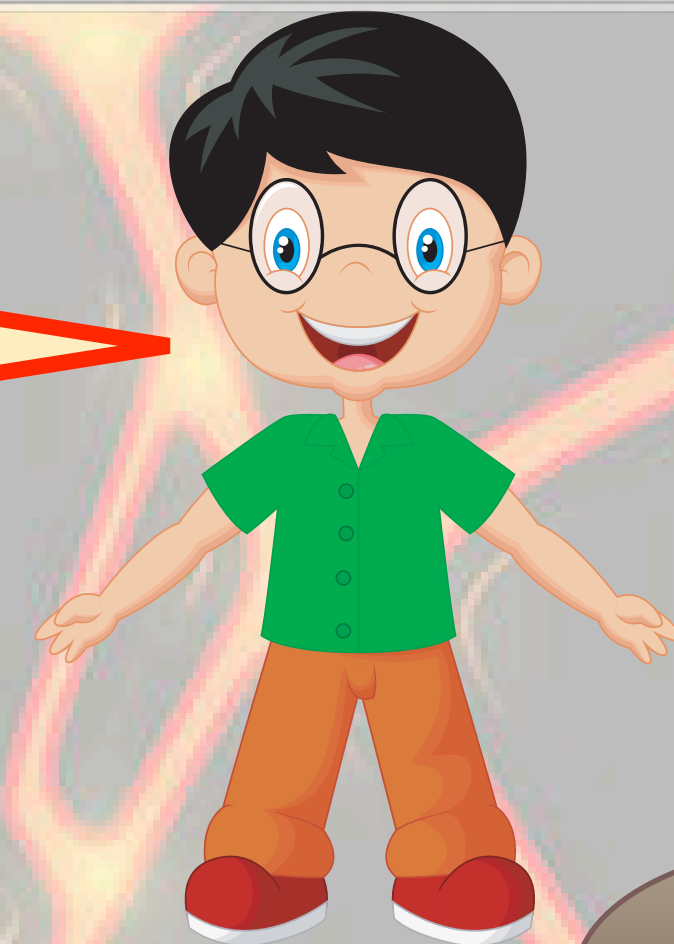
