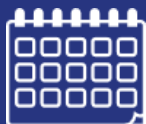

Online filtering and monitoring

Within our academy, we have monitoring and filtering systems that support the use of IT equipment including website and office document monitoring.

School staff are not permitted to have online interaction with children outside of these websites where feedback is given linked to academic celebrations. Any concerns must be reported to the Principal or DSL.

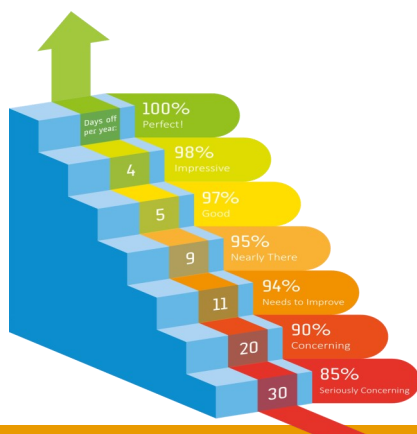
ATTENDANCE
